## **Topic: Replacing the Electronic Lock Assembly**

### **Removing the Electronic Door Lock Assembly**

- Unlock the cabinet top using the cam lock key and open.
- Remove the two holding screws from the front lock access cover with a Phillips screwdriver.
- Push the elevator down until the lock access cover folds down. This will hold the elevator in place and expose the lock and cabling.
- Unplug the 4-pin connector on the electronic door lock assembly from the 4-pin connector on the IMPACT cable assembly. **Figures (2,3)**
- Now, using the cam lock key, turn the cam lock all of the way to the right (clockwise) into the locked position. Figure (1)
- Loosen the ¼-turn fasteners on each end of the electronic door lock.
   Figure (3)
- Carefully lift and remove the electronic door lock from the rack.



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### **Installing the Electronic Door Lock Assembly**

- <u>Using the cam lock key, turn the cam lock all of the way to the right</u> (clockwise) into the locked position. Figure (1)
- Carefully place the lock assembly in position, making sure that the lock release spring fits through the hole in the mounting bracket (left side of plate) without jamming. Figures (3, 4)
- Tighten the ¼-turn fasteners on each end of the lock; making sure that it is secure. **Figure (3)**
- Attach the 4-pin connector on the lock to the 4-pin connector on the Impact cable assembly. The connectors are keyed for correct orientation. Make sure the connector snaps into place. Figures (2, 3)
- Stow the cabling so it is not exposed to moving parts. You can run the cabling through the slot in the rack's ribbing.
- Pull the lock access cover up and re-insert the holding screws. The elevator will automatically rise to its top position.

Note: Return the cam lock to the unlocked position (left side) <u>before</u> closing the rack top door. Then close the top and lock.
